Bakers Landing Section 1A and Detention Construction Project**


The contractor, Hurtado Construction Co., will be closing South Galveston Avenue from Lockheed to Hampshire Street; and Hampshire Street between South Main Street and Old Alvin Road on Monday, February 22, 2016 and continuing for approximately 5 months for construction of new detention facilities and improved water, sanitary sewer, and drainage facilities. Please use Old Alvin Road north to East Walnut Street to South Main Street as an alternate route (Detour A). Another route would be Old Alvin Road South to Swensen Road to South Main Street (Detour B).

Drivers should be aware of heavy equipment and construction personnel in the vicinity of the worksite, and be prepared for minor delays resulting from the construction work. This work however, should not interfere with access to any surrounding properties or businesses. The City urges all drivers to please exercise caution while in the area and obey all traffic controls and flaggers.
