Subject: TRAFFIC ADVISORY – NORTH AND SOUTH-BOUND TRAFFIC TO BE RE-ROUTED TO EAST SIDE OF MAX ROAD

Max Road Improvements Project – Max Road, Pearland, TX

The City of Pearland's contractor, SER Construction Partners, LLC., will close the southbound direction of traffic and re-direct all northbound (NB) and southbound (SB) traffic to the NB side of Max Road. The contractor will demolish the SB bridge and reconstruct a new bridge. While the existing bridge is being demolished and the new bridge constructed, the SB side of Max will remain closed. NB and SB traffic is expected to be restricted to the east side of Max Road for approximately 75 days, beginning Wednesday, August 8, 2018 at 9:00 a.m. Access to businesses and homes along the west side of Max Road will remain open.


Project activities are weather dependent and subject to change. Drivers should be aware of heavy equipment and construction personnel in the vicinity of the worksite, and be prepared for minor delays resulting from the construction work. The City urges all drivers to exercise caution while in the area and obey all traffic controls and signage. As a reminder, while construction is in progress, the speed limit is 30 miles per hour within the construction zone.

Justification: Consolidating traffic to the east side of Max Road will provide safer working and driving conditions, as there will be heavy machinery and equipment on the west side of Max Road during bridge demolition and construction. This temporary traffic switch allows the contractor to prosecute the work with all possible speed to reduce impact to residents and deliver project as quickly as possible.
