Frequently Asked Questions



What does the event look like?

- The Tri-a-little-thon event will take place at the John Hargrove Environmental Complex Trail behind the Delores Fenwick Nature Center.
- Participants will compete in three challenges:
 - 1st is our “mug club” which requires teammate #1 to sit on an inner tube while holding a mug. Teammate #2 will need to fill the mug using a water gun.
 - 2nd both teammates will enjoy a peaceful ride on a “bicycle build for two” as they pedal around one loop of the scenic JHEC Trail. Don’t forget to sing Daisy, Daisy give me your heart to do, I’m half crazy... (Sorry this song always gets stuck in my head when talking about a bicycle built for two).
 - 3rd, and final challenge requires both teammates to “caterpillar crawl” their way to the finish line using our customized caterpillar boards or in other words a team plank walk. (Secret tip: Channel your inner bug)
 - Don’t have an inner tube, tandem bike or wood planks?! No worries because you don’t need anything, we supply everything. Well... not everything, we still need you to show up
- Teams will be placed in heats, scheduled every 10 minutes, starting at 9 a.m.
- Awards will be given at the conclusion of all heats
